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### DID YOU KNOW...?

71% of the earth's surface is covered in water, yet only 3% of that water is fresh. Out of 3% of that fresh water, only .05% of it is available for us. Out of 10 billion people, 2 billion still do not have access to usable clean water.

The global water crisis is a major health risk, causing the death of millions annually.

There are also 3.5 billion people who still do not have access to safe sanitation.
Almost 8% of the world's population practices open defecation.

This leads to nearly 1000 children dying everyday.

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#### Solution

### 2024 DISCOVER BURKINA FASO-WATER/SANITATION MISSION

Discover Burkina Faso 2024. This missions trip is designed to introduce the country of Burkina Faso to the diaspora, while bringing our hearts and resources to help with the water crisis and public sanitation efforts. Burkina Faso is in the Sahel Region of West Africa, and is landlocked. Our missions trip will open the door to many more targeted missions, as well as door to the opportunities that are available for philanthropist and pioneers.



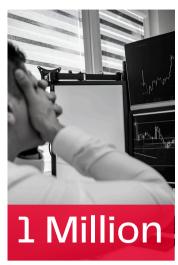
### **Problem**

#### Access to Drinking Water:



In Burkina Faso, only 69% of the population has access to clean drinking water. This means that over 30% of the population is still struggling to find safe and clean water sources for their daily needs.

#### **Displacement:**



Burkina Faso is currently facing a displacement crisis, with over 1 million people internally displaced due to conflict and violence. These individuals are in urgent need of basic necessities, including shelter, food, and healthcare.

### Under Educated Population:



Access to Global standard education is limited in Burkina Faso. Bo Foundation is building a school to provide access to STEM programs, foreign exchange opportunities, agriculture, Language and trades.

### Who We Are:

The BO Foundation advocates for equitable access to basic quality education, entrepreneurship and innovation, clean and safe drinking water, protecting the environment, quality health care as a basic human rights, and meaningful cultural exchange between Africans and the African diaspora throughout the world, with a particular focus on improving the quality of life for women and girls in Africa. Since 2017, the foundation has been impactful and successful with their mission to serve the people. Through our 7 initiatives, we have a missions trip to Burkina Faso, to invite philanthropist from around the world to be part of our mission, and help introduce Burkinabe to the world.





Mr. Ouedraogo is a passionate leader with first class communication skills. He has a long track record of successfully managing many projects and teams. He is experienced in domestic and international logistics, transportation, and renewable energy. The BO Foundation was officially founded in 2017, a non government non profit entity supporting the empowerment of women and youth in Burkina Faso, and the greater Sahel region.

BEAUTIFUL BURKINA is also an initiative she started, which is an environmental effort focused on removing trash from the streets, and bring environmental awareness to the people. #### **OUR IMPACT**

### We want to make a positive impact on the world.

In Burkina Faso, the maternal mortality rate and the infant mortality rate is high. Health and Wellness is one of our biggest initiatives where we have been able to make a huge difference. In 2021 we launched our Medical Equipment Container Project. Through our partner Hospital Sisters Mission Outreach, and MedWish in the United States, the BO Foundation acquired a 40 foot shipping container filled with over \$250,000 worth of hospital equipment, furniture, and supplies. The equipment was distributed to different community medical centers and has significantly improved healthcare access for nearly 300,000 underserved people.

My Sisters Keeper is a seminar on personal hygiene and reproductive health designed to teach young women and girls to become more familiar with their bodies, and help shatter the stigma around menstruation. The seminar gives practical and environmentally appropriate advice that includes homemade beauty secrets, like depilation methods, homemade deodorant and soaps, and proper skin and haircare. Between 2021 and 2022, we were able to reach 1000 girls in person, and distributed menstrual kits provided by DAYS FOR GIRLS INTERNATIONAL.

- -Parts/Equipment
- -Labor

Maintenance \$1,500 USD/year. Replacing and cleaning solar panels and faucets as needed.

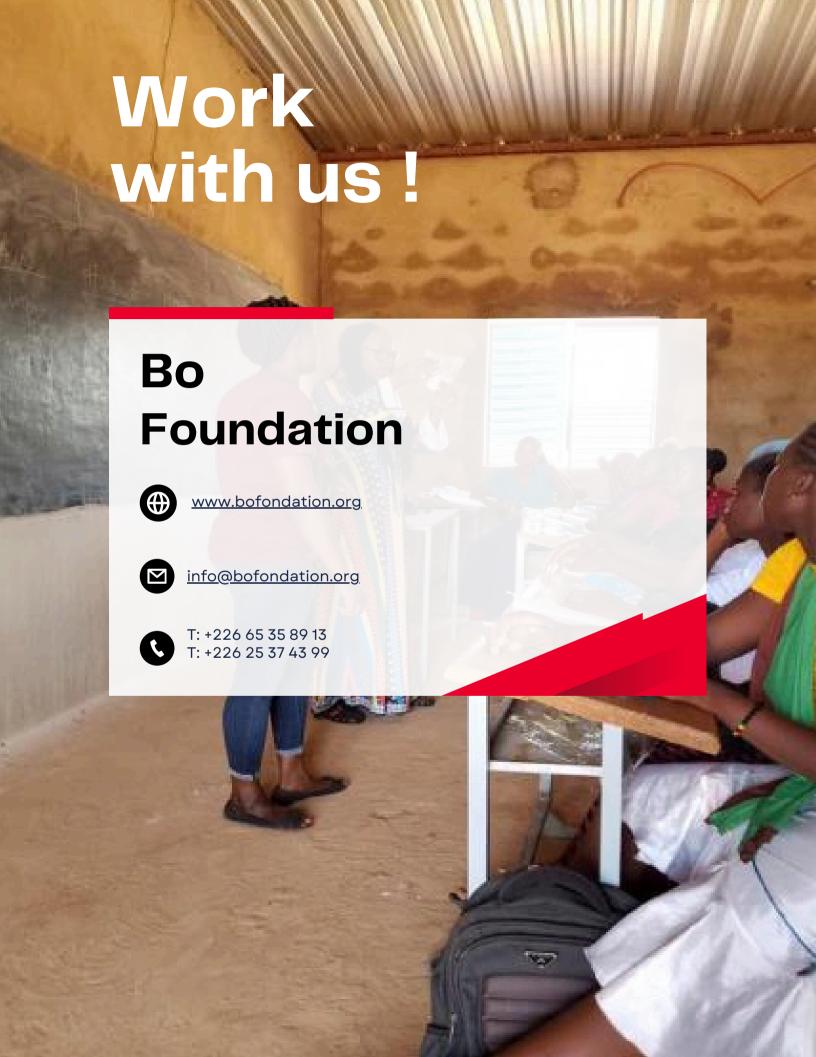
